Aurora Sister Cities International's mission focuses in large part on initiatives that provide opportunities for young people to understand the value of globalization in all of its many manifestations—business, trade, technology, diplomacy, security, migration, and peacebuilding.

Our Global Youth Leaders program, engages Aurora youth aged 13-15 in an interactive week-long leadership curriculum designed to give them the skills to act as global leaders, entrepreneurs, ambassadors, and pursue higher education opportunities.

Our program uses interactive activities to teach students a set of global competencies including Character, Citizenship, Communication, Creativity, and Culture.

Students who complete this program also have the opportunity to apply for a scholarship to attend the nationally-renowned Sister Cities International Youth Leadership Summit. This youth summit brings together students from diverse backgrounds and countries as well as some of the world's top business leaders, policy officials, lobbyists, diplomats, and academics.
