including Character, Citizenship, Communication, Creativity, and Culture.

Students may also apply for scholarships to attend the nationally-renowned Sister Cities International Youth Leadership Summit, which brings together students from diverse backgrounds and countries as well as some of the world's top business leaders, policy officials, lobbyists, diplomats, and academics.
